Your South Whiteshell Trail Association in partnership with Trails Manitoba is endeavoring to find a way to close the gap in the Trans Canada Trail along Penniac Bay. We have proposed new trail construction on public lands on the west side of PTH 44 as shown on the attached map.

Any route, which will close this trail gap and alleviate safety concerns of trail users on the highway, will impact property owners, businesses, and cottagers in the area.

Your input is needed before we move forward on plans to complete the Trans Canada Trail in 2017.

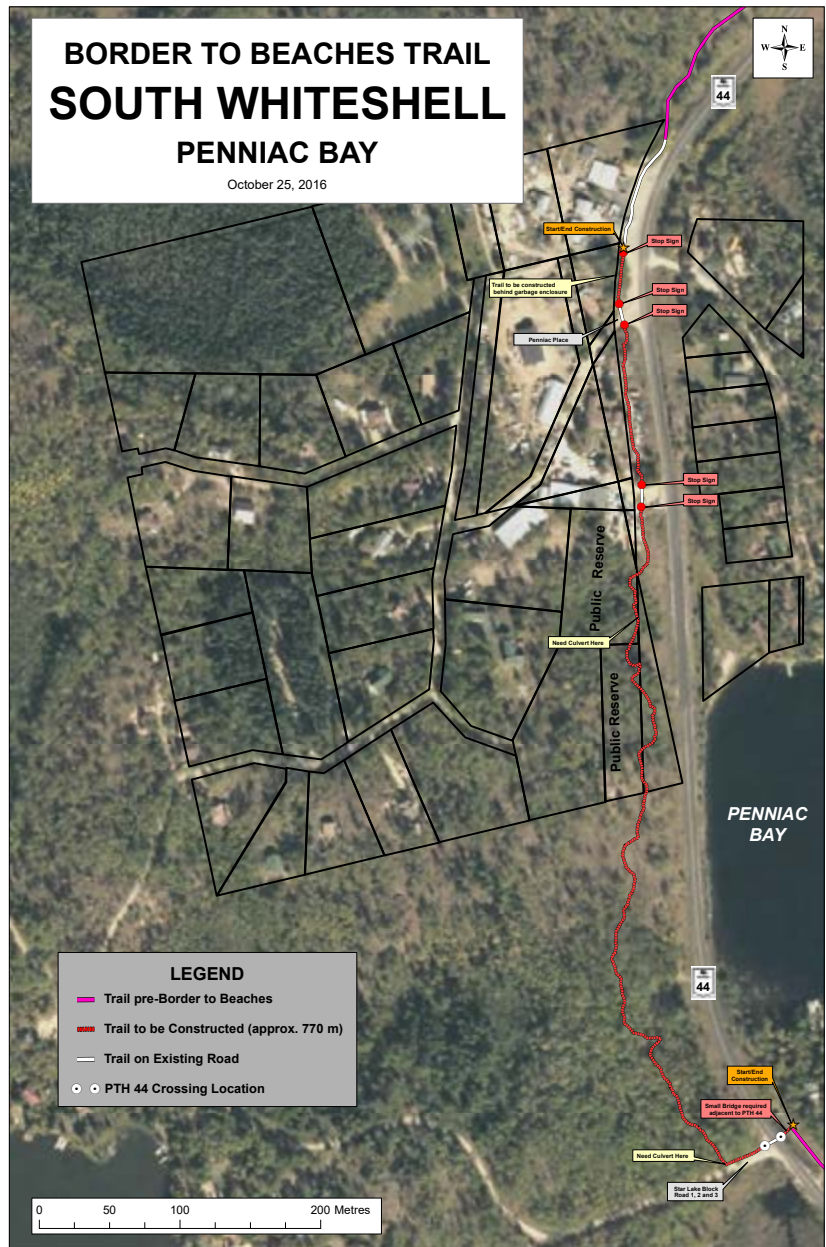

Funding of alternative proposals will also be discussed.
