

Environment Committee Report – April 6th , 2020

There have been no updated measurements for Caddy, Falcon and West Hawk in the last month. Nutimik and Lac du Bonnet have been updated as of April 7th as shown below.

The federal government real time monitoring station on the Whiteshell River, downstream of the Jessica Lake dam, shows the flow rates as of April 7th increased to 113 Cubic feet per second compared to 72 cubic feet per second at March 10th. Last year at this time the discharge rate was 58 cubic feet per second.
