Betula Lake Campground

June 5, 2023

A power outage on June 5, 2023 has led to the loss of water pressure in the Betula Lake Campground distribution system. Distribution depressurization can compromise the safety of the water supply; therefore, a boil water advisory has been issued to ensure public health protection. Tap Water must NOT be used for:

- drinking
- brushing teeth
- preparing food or beverages, including ice and infant formula
- washing dishes or other items that come into contact with food
- washing hands to prepare food or to eat food with your hands

DURATION

The Boil Water Advisory will remain in effect until the water supplied by this water system no longer presents a risk to public health.
