Job Duties:

Under the direction of the Park Works Supervisor and/or Designate:

A Labourer performs a variety of heavy and light manual duties associated with construction, maintenance, and works operations: includes janitorial duties and general landscaping and maintenance of facilities, may be required to operate various small equipment and tools.

An Operator will be required to operate various equipment including specialized mowers, light motor vehicles, tractors, and other small equipment. The Operator may also be required to perform maintenance and minor repairs on equipment, as well as keep daily operating and maintenance records.

Qualifications:

Essential:

- Must have previous experience operating and/or maintaining smaller mechanical equipment such as riding mowers, light automotive vehicles (i.e. Gators, ATV's), push mowers, chainsaws, brush-saws, etc.
- Experience interacting effectively with the public and co-workers, the ability to deal with stressful situations.
- Experience working independently and with minimal supervision.
- Previous janitorial experience.
- Knowledge and experience in landscaping.
- Previous experience with common hand tools used for manual labour.
- Experience keeping and maintaining written records.

- Experience with safe working practices.
