Under the direction of the Park Works Supervisor and/or Designate:

The incumbent will be responsible for the operation of mechanical equipment involved in varied construction and/or maintenance programs in the Whiteshell Provincial Park including tractor loader, wheeled tractor, 3-ton truck.
